



## **Dental Hygiene Application**

**Great News for Dental Hygiene Applicants: We now have a Baccalaureate degree completion pathway through a new "dual enrollment" opportunity with Metropolitan State University.** Partnering with Metropolitan State, we now offer the ASDH/BSDH dual admission program with simultaneous admission to Normandale Community College's Associate Degree in Dental Hygiene (ASDH) program and Metropolitan State University's Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene (BSDH) program. This unique partnership offers students the opportunity to complete specific bachelor's level degree completion courses along with associate program courses on the Normandale campus. This opportunity provides Dental Hygiene students flexibility in their educational and career planning. For those who are anxious to obtain a BSDH degree this may be accomplished within one or two semesters after completion of the ASDH Program.

## Application deadline is December 31st each year. Please note, the Dental Hygiene program requires high school graduation or GED. PSEO students are not eligible to enroll in the Dental Hygiene program.
