

## Dental Hygiene Application

**Great News for Dental Hygiene Applicants:** We have a Baccalaureate degree completion pathway through a “dual enrollment” opportunity with Metropolitan State University. Partnering with Metropolitan State, we offer the ASDH/BS DH dual admission program with simultaneous admission to Normandale Community College’s Associate Degree in Dental Hygiene (ASDH) program and Metropolitan State University’s Bachelor of Science in Dental Hygiene (BSDH) program. This unique partnership offers students the opportunity to complete specific bachelor’s level degree completion courses along with associate program courses on the Normandale campus. This opportunity provides Dental Hygiene students flexibility in their educational and career planning. For those who are anxious to obtain a BSDH degree this may be accomplished within one or two semesters, or self-paced, after completion of the ASDH Program.

**General Admission to Normandale Community College is required prior to applying for Dental Hygiene Admission.** The Dental Hygiene Application closes December 31st each year. The Dental Hygiene program requires high school graduation or GED. PSEO students are not eligible for admission into the Dental Hygiene program.

Completion of BIOL 2043 Microbiology including a lab with a grade of C or higher is strongly encouraged prior to application, as it is required for students admitted into the A.S. Dental Hygiene program. However, completion of Microbiology is not required at the time of application.
